### Pupil Premium—Does your child qualify?

Pupil Premium is extra money paid direct to schools for each child who is eligible for free school meals. It is used to support your child's education. Please apply for free schools meals if you are eligible, even if your child is in R, YR1 or YR2 and receiving Universal free school meals, so that our school receives this extra funding

Free School Meals can only be awarded if you or your partner are claiming either;

- Income Support
- Job Seekers Allowance – Income Based
- Employment and Support Allowance - Income Related
- Support under part V1 of the immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income that does not exceed £16,190
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.

Note: From 1st May 2009, children are eligible for Free School Meals for a four week period immediately after the parent/carer becomes unemployed, or reduces their hours to

less than 16 hours a week, but is still in receipt of Working Tax Credit.
