



Class 3 Autumn Term 2017



Class 3 have settled back into school quickly after their fun, festive break.

Our topic this term will be 'Ancient Greece'. The children will learn about the physical *Geography of Greece*, to place the Ancient Greek civilisation on a timeline, their beliefs, the daily life of Ancient Greeks and the impact of the Ancient Greek civilisation on the modern world. We will also be designing and creating a reproduction of the Pantheon and comedy and tragedy masks; in art the children will be decorating a pot in the style of Ancient Greek pottery. Our topic will also cover ICT, music and PSHE

In science we will be learning about Animals including humans, the focus will be on digestion and teeth.

In literacy, the children will be reading and learning about Ancient Greek myths and legends.

In numeracy, the children will be working on place value, addition and subtraction, coordinates and line graphs, multiplications and division, perimeter and area and fractions and decimals.

P.E. this term will be on a Monday afternoon (indoors) and a Friday afternoon (outdoors). Through dance, the children will re-enact the Ancient Greek Olympic games to music. In outdoor PE they will be doing hockey. Please can children have the correct school PE kit in school at all times, this includes shorts, t-shirt, tracksuit bottoms and trainers. Girls will need socks if they are wearing tights.

Homework will be given out on a Friday, to be returned by the following Thursday. The children's spelling test will be every Monday.
